

FAB Awards FAQ

Q. Can I start registration and come back to finish?

Yes, to begin registration, on our Judgify website, use your email address as login and create a password. You can begin registration and submissions, just save as draft before finalizing submission. Payment can be completed once after all entries are submitted.

Q. What payment methods are accepted?

Credit card over the phone, check by mail, and PayPal. Judgify adds a 3.5% service fee to ALL orders. We do not add an additional fee on our side.

Q. Are there refunds if I decide not to submit my project?

No. *There are no refunds once you have completed payment.* But, you can begin a submission, save it as a draft, and never finalize/submit it. You don't pay until your submission is complete.

Q. Can I add text to my image / photograph?

Yes. You can add a title and/or caption to your photograph before you save it as a PDF. Word count should not exceed 40 words.

Q. Can I design a single page/file of multiple images?

Yes. For example, a before and after photograph combined on one page may be highly relevant to your project submission. We recommend no more than 4 images per page/file.

Q. Can I upload more than one floor plan?

Yes. Only one floor plan is required for each project submission. You can include more than one floor of a project in the "File Upload - Floor Plan" location. The PDF file size must remain under 5MB. You have up to 10 additional files to support your project submission; any combination of sketches, diagrams, photographs, etc.

Q. How can I reduce the size of my PDF file?

A few suggestions: use standard fonts (Arial or Calibri), downsize images before inserting them into your PDF, and use vector images instead of raster images. Remember that this will be viewed on screen only, we will contact you if we need a high resolution image for printing purposes.

Q. Do I have to be an IIDA member to register?

No. You do not have to be an IIDA member to register. But, if there was an active IIDA member on the project team, the cost of that project submission is discounted. The IIDA Member name is requested on the "submission form".

Q. Does the whole project team have to reside within the IIDA Northland Chapter?

No. But we are celebrating the work of the IIDA Northland Chapter. We expect that the majority of the design work is being done by team members within the IIDA Northland Chapter (Minnesota, North Dakota, and South Dakota).

Q. Does the project have to be located in Minnesota?

No. The project can be located anywhere in the world. The design team/majority of the design work needs to have come out of the IIDA Northland Chapter (Minnesota, North Dakota, and South Dakota).
